OVERVIEW

The history of Persian Department is the history of Lahore College for Women University, Lahore. The Persian Department has a glorious past comprising of nine decades. In 1922 when Lahore College for Women was founded there were only few departments like Chemistry, English, Urdu, Philosophy, Physics, Economics, Political Science and one of these was the Persian Department. The key factor behind the establishment of the Persian department in Lahore College for Women was that the Persian language was the only official languageof the sub - continent starting from Mahmud Ghaznavi's period to the Sikh Era of the Punjab. In addition, seventy five percent of Urdu language is derived from Persian language. A great treasure of religious books is in Persian and many other have been translated in Persian language. These books are an authority in religious teachings too Many rare manuscripts are also available in Persian literature. The Department of Persian is one of the oldest departments of Lahore College for Women University, Lahore. The importance of this department has justified its existence in university and contributed to its growth. The department has produced prominent scholars like Dr. Aarfa Sayeda, Ms. Kishwer Naheed and Ms. Shabnam Shakeel who have enhanced its stature and status. Prominent faculty members like Mrs. Q.A Chishti, Syeda Ashraf Bokhari, Mrs. Saeeda Chaudhry, Mrs. Mehboob Abid Ali, Mrs. Nafeesa Athar, Mrs. Saeeda Asif, Dr. Khalida Aftab, Dr. Zamurrad Salman and Mrs. Rafia Shah have rendered their services in this department in the past.

The Persian Department is actively arranging and participating in various co – curricular activities within university and in other educational and cultural institutions. The co – curricular activities are comprised of essay writing competitions, poetry recitations, debates, declamation contents and Olympaid on Persian Language and Literature The several students of the Persian Department had visited Iran on full bright Scholarship and still a student from the Persian Department doing her MPhil degree from Iran on Scholarship.

IRANOLOGY CENTRE

The department maintains cordial relations with the Iran Culture Centre in Lahore, the embassy of Islamic Republic of Iran, and various Iranian universities. The Centre has contributed alot for the capacity building of the faculty and in strengthening the department. In October 2008, an MOU was signed between the Iran Culture Center, Lahore Lahore and Lahore College for Women University, Lahore. The implementation of the of the above referred MOU started in November, 2008, with the construction of In-charge office of Iranology Centre. The construction work was fully funded by the Iran Culture Center which included the construction of office along with a library. The aforementioned office was

inaugurated on 11th November, 2008. Furthermore, the Iran Culture also strengthened the office by providing furniture and fixture.

A delegation from Lahore College for Women University headed by the Vice Chancellor Dr. Bushra Mateen along with other three members including Ms. Faleeha Kazmi (Incharge Department of Persian) went on a one week visit to Iran i.e. from November 12 to 19, 2008). During their stay, the members of the delegation visited Mashaad, Tehran and Qum. The main purpose of the visit was to promote educational, cultural and inter – universities relations between the two brotherly countries.

The Centre has been provided with books, computers, a lcd tv, a water dispenser, tiles (imported from Mashhad, Iran) and furniture and fixture by the Iran Government to familiarize the women graduates and faculty of Lahore College for Women University,Lahore with the culture of Iran, so that they can take due advantage of this facility available at their doorstep. This project will serve as a strong measure in strengthening the mutual ties between the two nations i.e. Iran and Pakistan.

Establishment of Ferdowsi Chair at LCWU:

Abu'l-Qasim Ferdowsi Toosi (c.940-1020) has been a very famous Persian poet and theauthor of Shahnameh ("The Book of Kings"). He is celebrated as the most influential figurein Persian literature and the National poet of Iran. Ferdowsi's Shahnameh is the most popular and influential national epic in Iran and other Persian-speaking nations. Considering the importance of Ferdowsi's work, the Persian Department at Lahore College for Women University proposed establishing of Ferdowsi Chair in LCWU, to the Saadi Organization, government of Iran which was accepted very kindly. This Organization chose Prof. Dr. S. Faleeha Zahra Kazmi for the mentioned Chair because of her expertise in Persian epic literature. For this purpose, they also provided funds to the Persian Department which is a very kind and exceptional gesture under this chair. They Two young faculty members of the Department, Ms. Amber Zulfiqar and Ms. Maria Umer were invited to go to Iran to attend a fully funded teacher training course for one month through the Ferdowsi Chair.

Under the leadership of the Vice Chancellor, LCWU, prof. Dr. Uzma Quraishi, the Ferdowsi Chair has arranged the international conferences and workshops and visits of Persian students to attend the language courses and signed the MOUs:

- MS students went to Iran to join a Persian Language course, financed by Saadi Organization in November 2016.
- The Department of Persian also got more than 100 rare research books under this Chair.
- Saadi Organization Iran has also gifted a generator to the Ferdowsi Chair.
- The Ferdowsi Chair with the collaboration of Iran Cultural Centre, Lahore.
- This Chair organized a 3–Day international conference on "Shunning Sectarianism and Promoting Interfaith Harmony for Peaceful Coexistence in 2016".
- An International Conference on the theme "Commemoration of Ferdowsi Toosi" (13-15 March, 2017).

We can hope that after the establishment of the Ferdowsi Chair in Persian Department at Lahore College for Women University, the educational and cultural relations between Iranian and Pakistani institutes will flourish and it will also raise the research standards in Persian language and literature.
