# IdeaGist –Pilot Cohort 2– Entrepreneurship Training

Mr. Syed Hassan, CEO - IdeaGist, started his incubator in 2012. In 2019, Ideagist announced an increase in its technology investment from \$55 million to \$100m to support Prime Minister Imran Khan's vision on entrepreneurship and innovation in emerging technologies. The vision of LCWU is to provide quality education, accessible to all in order to produce empowered, creative women leaders in order to produce employable and entrepreneurial graduates who can contribute effectively to the job market. Keeping this vision in mind; ORIC-LCWU established liaison with Ideagist, in order to

enroll LCWU student for Cohort II of Ideagist in April, 2020. The deadline of the registrationwas 26th April, 2020. 113 applications were received from LCWU. The shortlisted startup had unlimited access to online resources for conversion of their ideas in to successful business. Online Graduation Ceremony will be held in the beginning of July, 2020; 15 startups will be graduating. Prof. Dr. Bushra Mirza, Worthy Vice Chancellor LCWU, will be addressing the audience on this auspicious event. Applications are open for Cohort III of this program till 30th July, 2020.



## Patent Filed

Accomplished Scientists from Department of Biotechnology Dr.Neelma Munir, Assistant Professor along with Prof. Dr. Shagufta Naz, Dean of Natural Sciences and Chairperson of the Department, LCWU, have been granted patent from IPO, Pakistan.
