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UNIVERSITY HIGHLIGHTS

LCWU Makes It to World Rankings at SDG Level

The Times Higher Education Impact Rankings are the only global performance tables that assess universities against the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals in which it carefully calibrates the indicators to provide comprehensive and balanced comparisons across three broad areas: research, outreach, and stewardship. The World Ranking of Universities (2020 edition) was released in April 2020 and it ranked LCWU 1st among Pakistani Universities and 15th in world top universities at Sustainable Development Goal Level 5. In SDG 17, LCWU secured 10th place among Pakistani universities, and 301-400 internationally. LCWU is striving to achieve gender equality by providing quality education to female students. We have a large number of PhDs in the faculty and are producing more doctoral candidates every year, this leads to achieve another milestone in sustainable socio-economic development.

Recruitment of 114 Vacant Regular Posts

In line with the Government policy to fill vacant posts, LCWU filled 114 vacant regular posts including Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers, Chief Security Officer and Senior Manager. Prof. Dr. Bushra Mirza, after her permanent appointment as Vice-Chancellor filled all the vacancies on merit and completed all the steps in a period of 6 months. In this regard, a ceremony was held at LCWU in which an offer letter was presented to 9 Professors, 1 Tenured Professor, 13 Associate Professors, 16 Associate Professors TTS, 17 Assistant Professors (including 4 for Jhang Campus), 53 Lecturers (including 15 for Jhang Campus), Chief Security Officer for Main Campus of Lahore, Sr. Manager, Chief Equipment Manager and 2 Lab Engineers.

National Women's Day Event

Seminar on Two Nation Theory and Rise of Hinduvta in India

Department of Pakistan Studies organised a Seminar titled "Two Nation Theory and Rise of Hinduvta in India'. The purpose of the seminar was to highlight the importance of Two-Nation Theory and to expose the growing Hinduvta thinking in India. Provincial Minister of Information Punjab Fayaz-ul-Hassan Chohan attended the seminar as the chief guest. Addressing the seminar, he said that Quaid-i-Azam, Allama Iqbal and other Muslim leaders of the subcontinent had initiated their struggle after realising that Hindus and Muslims were two separate nations with distinct civilisations, ways of living, traditions and customs. We need to understand the ideology of the BJP and Modi. Addressing the seminar, Syed Asadullah said that the two-nation ideology had begun with the liberation war of 1857 and Pakistan was the fruit of that struggle.





MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING, PROJECTS AND GRANTS

Mass Communication Department Signs MOU with Strengthening Participatory Organisation

Department of Mass Communication, LCWU, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on January 13, 2020 with Strengthening Participatory Organisation to foster academic collaboration and develop contemporary programs in the field of mass communication. The MOU was signed by Professor Dr. Bushra Mirza Vice Chancellor LCWU and Mr. Shahnawaz Khan Regional Head, SPO-Lahore. SPO will organise and facilitate internship programs for students of Department of Mass Communication, LCWU, on a yearly basis and award certificates to the students who will complete minimum 8 weeks internship program.



Faculty of Engineering and Technology Collaborates with Higher Education Commission of Sweden

The Faculty of Engineering and Technology has won a competitive proposal of approx. worth PK 2.5 Million Rupees from the Higher Education Commission of Sweden. An academic collaboration was launched officially between Lahore College for Women University and Department of Software Engineering, Karlstad University, Sweden which will foster research and development culture for women empowerment in the engineering sector of Pakistani universities. The proposal was jointly submitted by Dean Prof. Dr Intesar Ahmad & Dr. Muhammad Mohsin Nazir Associate Professor, LCWU. This proposal includes faculty and student exchange programs, strengthening and preparation of curriculum on emerging disciplines with a focus on sustainable research commercialisation, including joint conferences and workshops in computing and allied engineering disciplines.

LCWU Launches Learning Management System

LCWU successfully launched its Learning Management System (LMS) on June 12, 2020. The LMS has provisions of content delivery and assessment with integrated monitoring mechanisms, with. The Online LMS is accessible from home and the faculty, as well as students, may benefit from its responsive environment. The IT Directorate of the LCWU acquired and configured the LMS in a record time of less than 2 months. A total of 46 Departments, more than 600 faculty members and 11200 students will benefit from this LMS. The LMS is available for online classes of more than 1769 courses of BS, MA/MSc, MS/ M Phil and PhD levels for both the campuses of the University, Lahore as well as Jhang.

The objective behind this project is to help those in need on a smaller scale, initially without cost. The main target will be public, who is going through pressure and mental health issues. The project will facilitate in Corona Consultation, briefing about corona and precautions, counselling quarantine patients and caregivers, dealing with stress, anxiety and depression, addressing psycho social aspects of corona, bereavement counselling to families, health tips to boost immunity.

Far-reaching Impact of TEDxLCWU — Collaboration between 'Mother and Baby in Need' (MABIN) Organization and 'Rizq Enterprise'

A very positive and promising outcome of the TEDxLCWU event hosted on December 21st, 2019, came to light in the form of a recent collaboration between 'Mother and Mother And Baby In Need' (MABIN) Organization and 'Rizq Enterprise' (April 2020). Dr. Sadia Malick a leading Obstetrician and Gynecologist working in Saudi Arabia and Pakistan, was one of the featured speakers of TEDxLCWU 2019, talking about maternal and infant mortality. She worked constantly with many government and private organizations, and has succeeded in developing the birthing kits to be used in home deliveries by lady health workers and dais. Dr. Sadia Malick with the organizers of TEDxLCWU, entered an agreement with Rizq Enterprise, who have teams of workers delivering food and rations to the needy and deserving families in the major cities of Pakistan. In this collaboration the birthing kits will be supplied free of charge by 'Mother and Mother And Baby In Need' (MABIN) Organization, and the Rizq team will take charge of collecting information about the families where there may be an imminent birth, and then delivering the birthing kits well in time for the birth. Dr. Sadia Malick is currently working on developing tutorials and an app which will guide the health workers about how to use the birthing kit.



Rizq LCWU Qurbani Drive and Donations for LCWU Guards 2020

Rizq LCWU, in collaboration with Rizq Enterprise, started an online qurbani portal and took the responsibility of distributing Qurbani among the deserving on the occasion of Eid ul Adha.
