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

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

A ceremony was held to officially hand over the teaching materials to the Independent Living Centre, LCWU as part of the project titled "A Step Ahead towards Diversity and Inclusivity: Facilitating Learning of Basic Mathematics and Statistics to Blind Girls at Lahore College for Women University, Lahore, Pakistan". This project, was won by Dr. Asifa Kamal (Principal Investigator) and Dr. Mariyam Hafeez (Co-Principal Investigator). Funding was awarded by the Elsevier 2023 Mathematical Sciences Sponsorship Fund (MSSF).

The initiative aims to empower blind girls by equipping them with essential tools and resources to excel in basic mathematics and statistics. Prof. Dr. Uzma Qureshi, the Worthy Vice Chancellor, LCWU, graced the ceremony and commended the efforts of the Principal Investigator, Co-Principal Investigator, and the entire faculty of the Statistics Department in supporting visually impaired students in their learning journey. She interacted with the visually impaired students, encouraging them to harness their potential in STEM fields and reaffirming her commitment to fostering diversity in LCWU's educational process.



for Women University (LCWU), participated in the Women Empowerment & Mentoring Program (WEMP) from Jan 28th to April 28th, 2025.



WORKSHOP ON "IMAGE ANALYTICS IN DATA SCIENCE: A HANDS-ON WORKSHOP"

Dr. Asifa Kamal (COD), Dr. Sadia Khalil (Assistant Professor), Ms. Naz Saud (Assistant Professor), and Ms. Noor Shahid (Lecturer) from the Department of Statistics, Lahore College for Women University (LCWU), attended a two-day hands-on workshop titled "Image Analytics in Data Science" held from May 29th to 30th, 2025, at Forman Christian College (A Chartered University). The workshop provided valuable practical exposure to modern image processing techniques, machine learning applications, and deep learning models used in image analytics. The sessions enhanced the



participants' understanding of how unstructured image data can be leveraged for predictive modeling, pattern recognition, and decision-making in data science. 
