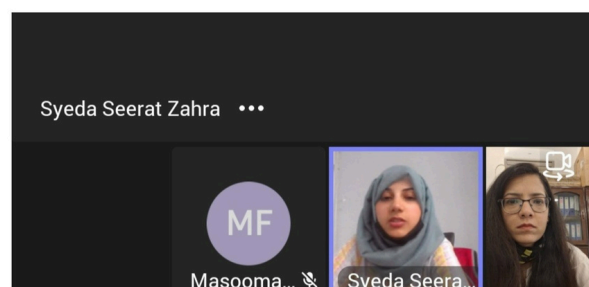


CAREER DRIVE BY SKIN DEEP & COTTON WEB
