Trainings on Entrepreneurship

British Council DICE grant for Social and creative Incubation Program

LCWU in collaboration with Cranfield School of Management UK, National University for Modern Languages (NUML), Centre for Global Innovators (CGI), and Sustainable Development Policy Institute (SDPI) has won British Council DICE grant for Social and creative Incubation Program. The one year grant has been awarded for capacity building of women entrepreneurs and will support up to 20 start-ups at LCWU. The launching ceremony was held in NUML. Addressing the participants, Prof Dr. Farkhanda Manzoor highlighted the importance of Entrepreneurship in the wake of the escalating crisis of non-availability of jobs for youth in Pakistan. She hoped that this program will encourage, educate and empower young entrepreneurs. She further stated that this program will offer young women multiple opportunities to demonstrate their knowledge, skills and diverse talents in entrepreneurship. ORIC in collaboration with Centre of Global Innovators (CGI) initiated the 1st call for startups 2019 at LCWU; 101 teams applied for this programme. After scrutiny, 40 teams were shortlisted and called for parallel presentation/interview on 18th March 2019 at Biotechnology Seminar Room, Biotechnology Meeting Room and Architecture Computer Laboratory. As a result, 20 teams were selected to participate in the Cohort-I of this Programme. After several training sessions, Cohort -I has been successfully completed in September, 2019.

Cohort II has been successfully launched on 10th of October, 2019. It includes different modules regarding entrepreneurship such as leadership, creativity and innovation, social impact and social media marketing. 20 teams will be incubated under this program. The startups selected participated in the demo day organized by PLAN9 and PLANX on 7th November 2019.
